- * Access current approaches and strategies to content learning

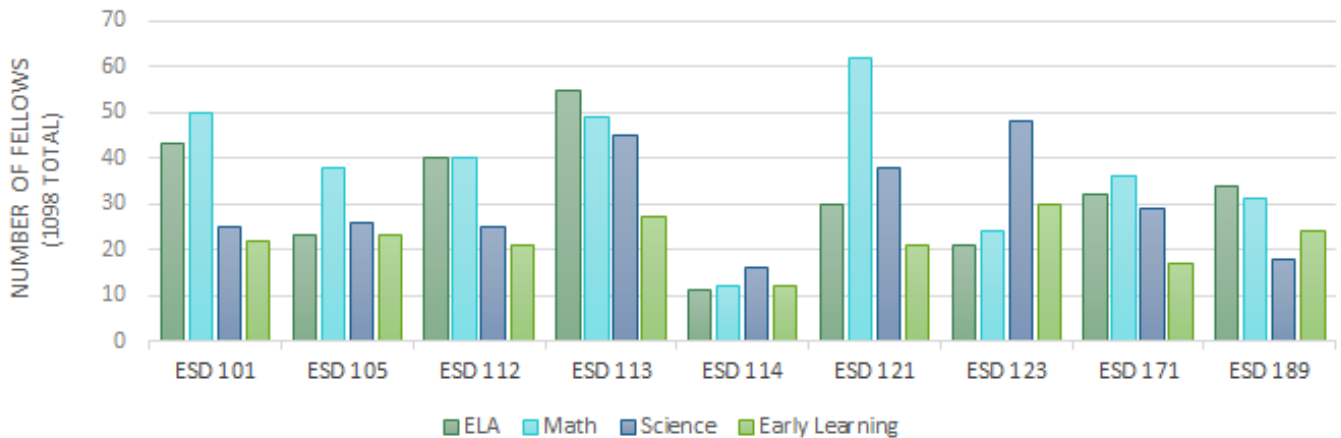


New Fellows Orientation: Fellows engaging in *Making Change Happen*, a simulation experience guiding participants through the challenges and rewards of becoming a change agent.
