## Food Handlers

## All Kitsap County food worker card classes and testing now done on-line

*In-person classes discontinued in 2017*



As of January, 2017, all classes and testing for food worker cards must be done on-line. The Kitsap Public Health District will no longer offer in-person classes.

The required course and test is available at [www.foodworkercard.wa.gov](http://www.foodworkercard.wa.gov). Note: Other websites that appear to offer a similar card online are not valid in Washington.

If you do not have access to a computer or the internet, you can take the test at the Kitsap Public Health District office (345 6<sup>th</sup> Street, Suite 300 in Bremerton) Monday – Friday between 8:30 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. You should plan on an hour to complete the class and take the test.
