Policy Clarifications

OHS - PC - A -075

Can Head Start Programs count speech services that local school systems are required to provide to children eligible under the individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), at no charge to Head Start, as non-federal share (in-kind donation)?

The time used to provide special education and/or related services by a therapist provided by a local Education Agency (LEA) may be considered by the Head Start Program as volunteer time for in-kind match purposes to the extent that part or all of the therapists pay is from non-





federal sources. In that case, and assuming none of those non-federal resources are being used to match any other federal grant, the portion of the therapist's salary (and fringe benefits) coming from non-federal sources should be used to calculate the non-federal share that can be claimed for that therapist's work in the Head Start program. Calculations on the value of the service must be consistent with the rate of a therapist with similar credentials and experience plus an appropriate amount of fringe benefits.
