OESD 114 and Kitsap Community Resources offer several programs to assist Kitsap and North Mason County families and children in reaching their family and developmental goals.

home based

This program serves families from pregnancy and children through age three. A qualified home visitor will visit and support you and your child once weekly for 90 minutes. Bi-monthly in-center Parent-Child Activity Days provide an opportunity for children and families to interact. The program is provided at no cost to those who qualify.

full day preschool

This program serves children from six weeks through five years old. Families must have a demonstrated need for full day and full year services. Services are provided five days a week, for a minimum of six hours a day. EHS and HS services are provided at no cost to those who qualify.

Use of child care hours will require a child care subsidy.

part-day preschool

This program serves children from three to five years old. Services are provided part-time, three or four days a week. Classes are in session September through May with some year-round options available. Services are provided at no cost to those who qualify.

Our programs create and cultivate social skills, cultural pride, a sense of belonging, language and academic skills, respect for others, and self confidence.






