

OESD 114 and Kitsap Community Resources offer several programs to assist Kitsap and North Mason County families and children in reaching their family and developmental goals.

home based

This program serves families from pregnancy and children through age three. A qualified home visitor will visit and support you and your child once weekly for 90 minutes. Bi-monthly in-center Parent-Child Activity Days provide an opportunity for children and families to interact. The program is provided at no cost to those who qualify.

full day preschool

This program serves children from six weeks through five years old. Families must have a demonstrated need for full day and full year services. Services are provided five days a week, for a minimum of six hours a day. EHS and HS services are provided at no cost to those who qualify.

Use of child care hours will require a child care subsidy.

part-day preschool

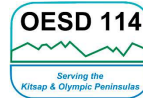
This program serves children from three to five years old. Services are provided part-time, three or four days a week. Classes are in session September through May with some year-round options available. Services are provided at no cost to those who qualify.

home based early head start



home based early head start



The Home Based Early Head Start program is designed for prenatal mothers, infants, and toddlers in Kitsap and North Mason County. Families and children will take part in fun activities that promote child development. The program is designed to:

- Build family attachment and promote your child's self-esteem
- Provide specialized services for children with special needs
- Offer support and access to community resources

This year-round, no-cost program is available for families with children from birth to three years old that qualify for Early Head Start services, but do not require all-day care.

how it works

The caring, qualified Home Based Early Head Start staff believes that you are your child's first and most important teacher. In this model, a qualified home visitor will meet with your family once weekly in your home for a 90-minute session. Your home visitor will share fun activities that promote your child's development and help them grow mentally, socially, emotionally, and physically. You'll also receive ideas to help you and your child boost school readiness.

additional information

We work with the whole family to promote self-esteem and help build strong and healthy family relations. Your home visitor is also trained to support your family in accessing community resources and referrals.

The Home Based Early Head Start Program offers in-center Parent-Child Activity Days twice a month, allowing you to connect with other families while teaching socialization skills to your child. As a participant in the program, you are encouraged to share your input and help us to create the kind of program that will best serve you and your family.
