PURPOSE

To collaborate with families to provide developmentally appropriate vehicle and pedestrian safety training to keep children safe.

PROCEDURE

Head Start and ECEAP, EHS- Center-Based:

- Pedestrian and Vehicle Safety training will be provided for children within the first 60 days of the program year and as needed.
- Education staff will use the Talk About Touch (Unit I, Lesson 2- Learning Traffic Safety) curriculum and may use other materials and resources to supplement if desired.
- Education staff will document activities pertaining to this training on their lesson plan/s.
- Pedestrian and Vehicle Safety training will be provided with families within the first 60 days of the program year, preferably at the first Family Gathering, and as needed. Attendance will be documented in ChildPlus per procedure.

EHS- Home-Based, Head Start- Home-Based, and Home Visitors:

- Pedestrian and Vehicle Safety training will be provided for children and families within the first 60 days of the program year, preferably at the first Family Gathering or Socialization of the year, and as needed. Attendance will be documented in ChildPlus per procedure.
- Education staff will use the Talk About Touch (Unit I, Lesson 2- Learning Traffic Safety) curriculum and may use other materials and resources to supplement if desired.
