OLYMPIC ESD 114 BOARD POLICY RISK MANAGEMENT

POLICY 6500

The Olympic Educational Service District 114 (OESD) Board of Directors (Board) is committed to providing a safe and healthful environment for its students and employees. To fulfill this commitment, the Board directs the Superintendent or designee to develop and maintain a risk management program to identify and measure risks of loss due to the damage or destruction of OESD property or to claims against the OESD by others claiming to have been harmed by the action of inaction of the OESD, its officers or staff. In addition, the risk management program shall:

- provide employees safety information and training, accident prevention, and prevention of transmission of communicable diseases;
- identify, assess, and reduce or eliminate risks of injury where possible;
- implement a system of reporting and recording accidents and potential hazards; and
- comply with state and federal safety requirements.

The OESD shall provide insurance coverage necessary for staff in the conduct of the OESD's financial and other operations.
