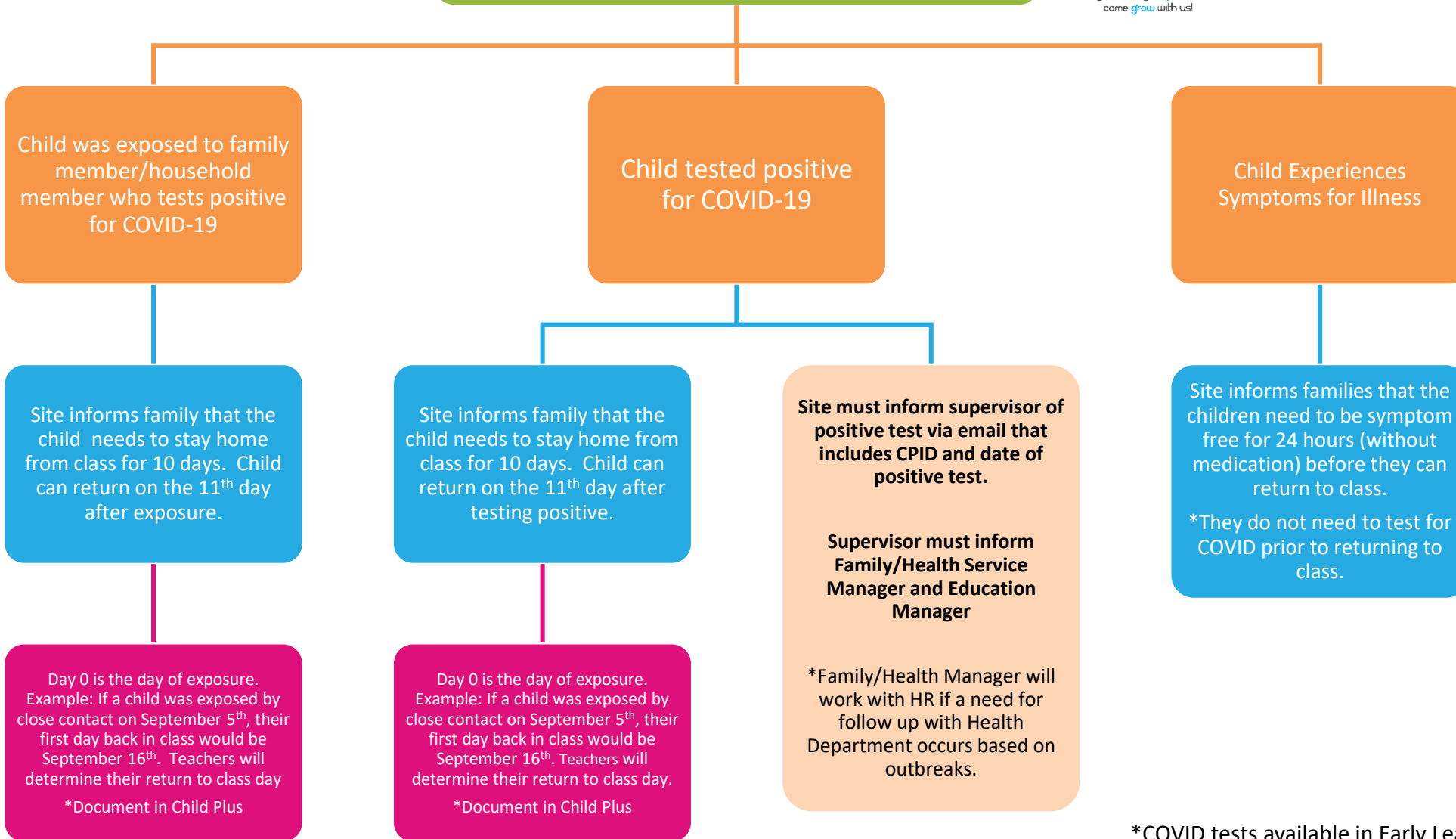
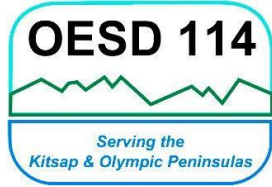


Children and COVID-19 Center Based Programs

Children and COVID-19 Home Based Programs



Child was exposed to family member/household member who tests positive for COVID-19

Child tested positive for COVID-19

Staff informs family that home visits will resume 10 days after exposure

Staff informs family that home visits will resume 10 days from the positive test.

Staff must inform supervisor of positive test via email that includes CPID and date of positive test.

Supervisor must inform Family/Health Service Manager and Education Manager

*Family/Health Manager will work with HR if a need for follow up with Health Department occurs based on outbreaks.

Home Visitors will determine their home visit that can return to the home

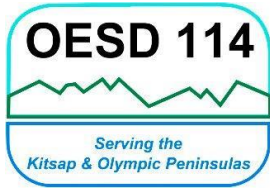
Day 0 is the day of exposure. Example: If a child was exposed by close contact on September 5th, your first in person HV would be September 16th.

Staff and COVID 19



Staff was exposed to someone who tests positive for COVID-19

*regardless of vaccination status

Staff Notify Supervisor

Supervisor informs the staff member that they can continue with all work related activities.

Monitor for symptoms.

It is recommended that staff wear a mask after exposure.

Test 2 days from exposure.

Staff tests positive for COVID-19

Staff notify supervisor of positive result immediately including day of test result and previous 3 days of work related activity.

Supervisor informs the staff member that they must isolate at home and will be contacted by Family/Health Manager. Supervisor must inform Family/Health Manager and Education Manager(s) and include all appropriate information.

Family/Health Manager will send follow up email(s) regarding isolation days and return to work expectations including date and mask requirement.

Communication will include:

Date staff can return to work (day 6)

Can return to work on day 6 if no fever within the past 24 hours (no medication) and symptoms have significantly improved.

Upon return to work, staff must wear a mask at **all** times for days 6-10.

Family/Health Manager follows up with other staff about potential exposure and watching for symptoms if necessary.
