Procedure

Each live plant in classrooms will be labeled with the name of the plant. The name can be either a label placed on the pot or the original label that comes with the plant.

Common poisonous plants:

- Hyacinth
- Narcissus
- Daffodil
- Oleander
- Dieffenbachia
- Philodendron
- Rosary Pea
- Castor Bean
- Poinsettia
- Mistletoe
