



Purpose

The Stand-Up Diapering Procedure describes how to support and assist changing children's diaper/pull up who is able to stand up on their own. Stand-Up Diapering Procedure is posted in the classroom bathroom OR kept in the Stand-Up Diapering backpack if the classroom does not have a bathroom.

Procedure

- 1. Wash hands.
- 2. Gather necessary supplies (diaper/pull-up/underpants, wipes, absorbent disposable underpad if needed, cleaner and sanitizer, paper towels, gloves, plastic bag).
- 3. Put on disposable gloves.
- 4. Coach child in pulling down pants and removing diaper/pull-up/underpants (assist as needed).
- 5. Put soiled diaper/pull-up/underpants in plastic bag (or assist child in doing so).
- 6. Coach child in cleaning diaper area front to back using a clean, damp wipe for each stroke (and assist as needed).
- 7. Put soiled wipes in plastic bag (or assist child in doing so).
- 8. Put absorbent disposable under pad in plastic bag (if used).
- 9. Close and dispose of plastic bag into hands-free covered trashcan lined with a plastic garbage bag.
- 10. Remove gloves
- 11. Wash hands and coach child in doing the same.
- 12. If a signed medication authorization indicates, apply topical cream/ointment/lotion using disposable gloves then remove gloves.
- 13. Coach child in putting on clean diaper/pull-up/underpants and clothing and washing hands(in bathroom/handwashing sink).
- 14. Close and put any bag of soiled clothing or underpants into child's cubby.
- 15. Follow 3-step method on floor where change has occurred (unless bathroom is located outside of the classroom and an absorbent under pad is used).
- 16. Wash hands (in bathroom/handwashing sink).
