3-Day Survival Kit-Emergency Food Supply (**5-year expiration**): A 3-day emergency food and water supply is required to keep children and staff safe during a disaster. Each bag contains drinking water, high calorie food bar, an emergency blanket, light stick, and towelettes.

- 1-year expiration foods: these foods will most likely be utilized first. (renew before expiration)
- Consider your center/site needs and special diets.
- Avoid food waste and expiration and consider having a disaster-free end of year celebration on the last day of class. Use "1 year expiration foods" in your disaster kit and have a "practice emergency snack".
- Examples of food items (choose 2):
  - $\circ \quad \text{Apple Sauce} \quad$
  - o Crackers
  - o Protein Bar
  - Craisins or other dried fruit
- Infant emergency supply of ready-to-feed formula and cereal, jarred baby food. (renew before expiration)
- 1 cases of water (replace annually)
