Purpose

The Devereux Early Childhood Assessment (DECA) is the social-emotional/behavioral screening tool used in our early learning programs to identify social emotional strengths and concerns and is required for every child. This informs staff about social emotional screenings due dates, timelines and follow up requirements.

Procedure

The DECA is completed with all children that enter our program even if they have an IFSP/IEP. This tool is completed three times a year to allow for evaluating the effectiveness of strategies, to show results and support families.

For newly enrolled children, the Parent Pre-DECA is due within **45 calendar days of a child's First Date of Service (FDS)** no matter what rating period the child enters the program.

For year-round programs and continuing children, a new Parent Pre-DECA must be completed prior to October 31.

Center Based Programs:

- The Parent Pre-DECA is completed by parent/caregiver within 45 days of a child's FDS.
- The Teacher DECA is completed by the Teacher and **is not** to be completed in the first four weeks. Staff completing the DECA should remain the same throughout the year. For example: If Teacher A completes the pre-DECA for Child 1, then Teacher A must complete the mid-DECA and the post-DECA for Child 1.
- Follow the scoring directions as outlined in the DECA portal.

Home Visiting Programs:

- The Parent Pre-DECA is completed by parent/caregiver and Home Visitor within 45 days of a child's FDS.
- Follow the scoring directions as outlined in the DECA portal.

If the family's primary language is anything other than English, you must request an interpreter to support completion. Staff should supply interpretive services and translated materials for screenings as available.

DECA Follow Up

 Child scores typical or strength in all areas Share results with the parent/caregiver to determine next steps within 2 weeks of the completed screening. Parent letters are printed from eDECA and shared with families and document conversation in CP Event notes. Parent and Teacher Single Rating Reports are attached in ChildPlus for each rating period.
